

Hosting a Community Campus

Overview

Community Campuses are local learning hubs powered by WonderED Learning and hosted by trusted community partners. These spaces enable flexible, personalized learning rooted in real-world experiences.

This guide outlines expectations, support, and steps for becoming a Community Campus Host.

What is a Community Campus?

A Community Campus is a physical location where WonderED students can:

- Engage in project-based learning
- Meet with advisors or facilitators
- Attend workshops or enrichment sessions
- Collaborate with peers and mentors

Campuses operate 1–5 days per week, depending on partner capacity.

Core Requirements

Requirement	Description
Safe Physical Space	Clean, accessible environment with basic furniture and internet access
Supervision	At least one trained adult present during student hours
Wi-Fi and Power	Reliable internet and outlets for student devices
Student Access	Location available on consistent weekly schedule
Background Checks	Hosts must comply with state regulations for working with minors

Optional Enhancements

- Regular enrichment offerings (e.g., STEM, arts, wellness)
 - Guest speakers, community mentors
 - Field trips or local service learning
 - Open house events for families and student showcases
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WonderED's Support Includes:

- Access to curriculum-aligned projects and planning tools
 - Onboarding and professional learning for facilitators
 - Branding and promotional materials
 - Optional site visits or coaching
 - Credit certification and evaluation guidance

Wednesday	Community Workshop + Reflection
Friday	Peer Collaboration + Progress Review

1. **Submit Application** – Indicate interest via our Community Partner Application Form
 2. **Discovery Meeting** – Collaborate with our team to define goals and logistics
 3. **Site Review & Agreement** – Walkthrough (in person or virtual) and finalize agreement
 4. **Launch** – Begin welcoming learners and building community!
